

Tourist Committee General Coordinator
Hereby. –

The State Health Commission approved the strategy for the Semana Santa and Easter Weekend in different tourist destinations during the past session celebrated on March 11th, 2021, establishing extraordinary health measures for such dates, divided by activity, business, and service.

These attached measures were presented at the past March 12th meeting and, in presence of the C. State Governor, Lic. Claudia Pavlovich Arellano, celebrated with different State and Municipal authorities, companies' representatives, and civil associations, in which it was agreed the implementation of security corporations and competent government employees.

Nevertheless, during the past days the epidemiologic indicators stated a substantial and consistent increase in the positive cases, from 17.8% to 29.2% and we can notice a sustained increase in contagion during the same period.

Therefore, the following measures will be added to reinforce the contingency strategi measures and to avoid relapses or a "third wave" derived from the social interaction during Semana Santa and Easter Weekends:

- ✓ Present a COVID-19 PCR or antigen test with negative results in order to access the touristic destination.
- ✓ Present a proof of residency and/or a Hotel Reservation in order to access the touristic destination.

To facilitate access to touristic destination and help the local authorities we are sending you the following information and we are available to respond any concern you may have.

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1. Public Beaches

- Security will be coordinated by municipal authorities with the participation of security companies and competent government employees.
- Access hours will be from 6:00 to 20:00 hours.
- Limited access to 50% of its capacity
- Are not allowed:
 - Sales of alcoholic beverages
 - Music Groups, mobile and set sound systems, included private vehicles.
 - Parties or social meetings at beaches or touristic places.
 - Sport events or amenities that conglomerate more than 10 persons.
 - Tents, stay overnight, and any kind of activities after 20:00 hours.
- Set and mobile stand must respect the access hours and established service rules and implement all the health security protocols.
- Must wear face mask, social distancing of 5 feet, use hand sanitizer and frequent hand washing for all the clients, among other health and personal protection.

2. Malecones, public spaces and traditional meeting points, as kiosks, parks, turnarounds and all public streets.

- Security must be coordinated by local authorities with the participation of security companies and competent government employees.
- Access hours will be from 6:00 to 20:00 hours.
- Limited access to 50% of its capacity.
- Sale of alcoholic beverages are not allowed.
- Music Groups, mobile and set sound systems, included private vehicles.
- Set and mobile stand must respect the access hours and established service rules and implement all the health security protocols.

3. Sport Fishing and Tourist boats

- Security must be coordinated by Port Captain and Marine Secretary in coordination with local authorities.
- Access hours will be from 6:00 to 20:00 hours or the working hours determined by Port Captain.
- Sport fishing will operate at 60% of its capacity, including ship's crew.
- Tourist boats will operate at 60% of its capacity, including ship's crew.
- Sale of alcoholic beverages, live music and dance in all kind of boats are not allowed.
- All health and security protocols must be followed, such as wear face mask, temperature measurement, signaling, social distancing of 5 feet, hand sanitizer use and frequent hand washing for all the clients, as well as other health and personal protection protocols stated by Port Captain for all boats.

4. Hotels, Motels and Guest Centers

- COESPRISSON is responsible of security in coordination with local authorities.
- Hotels and motels can operate at 60% of its capacity.
- Condominiums, Villas and similar can operate at 60% of its capacity.
- Hotel's Restaurants and guest amenities service hours are from 6:00 to 22:00 hours. Room Service does not have limited hours.
- Bars and amenities hours are from 6:00 to 22:00 hours.
- Hotel Bar's and restaurant's will operate at 50% of its capacity.
- Pools and other amenities and hotel facilities will operate at 60% of its capacity from 6:00 to 20:00 hours.
- Hotel and lodging facilities party and meeting rooms will operate at 50% of their capacity, without dance floor and live bands, from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm.
- Compliance with current sanitary safety protocols dictated by health authorities, such as: temperature measurement, mandatory and permanent use of face masks, use of gloves by the staff, social distance signage, hand sanitizer dispensers, periodic sanitization, operation with open windows, among others.

5. Restaurant-Bar, Restaurant and similar businesses with consumption and food sale

- COESPRISSON is responsible of security in coordination with local authorities.
- Working Hours from 6:00 to 22:00 hours, take-out, or home delivery until 24:00 hours.
- Will operate at 50% of its capacity in closed places.
- Will operate at 60% of its maximum capacity in open-air locations.
- Will only serve to seated customers and will only admit customers with facemask.
- Will operate without live music or dance floor.
- Reinforce current sanitary safety protocols such as social distance between tables, temperature measurement, signage, hand sanitizer dispensers, among others.

6. Nightclubs and nightclubs

- COESPRISSON is responsible of security.
- Suspended.

7. Party and Meeting Halls

- COESPRISSON is responsible of security in coordination with local authorities.
- Operation hours from 6:00 to 22:00 hours.
- In closed places, they will operate at 50% of its capacity, without dance floor and live bands.
- In open space venues, they will operate at 60% of its maximum capacity, without dance floor and live music.



- Mandatory use of facemasks, temperature measurement, signage, healthy distance of at least 5 feet, use of hand sanitizer, frequent hand washing, hand sanitizer dispensers, among other health protection measures.

8. Private homes.

- Security must be coordinated by local authorities.
- Suspension of parties permits, live music hiring and digital sound systems.
- Avoid conglomerations of more than 10 people, preferably from the same family.

9. Shopping malls and plazas, convenience stores and similar

- COESPRISSON is responsible of security in coordination with local authorities.
- Will operate from 6:00 to 22:00 hours.
- Will operate at 75% of maximum capacity.
- Compliance with current health safety protocols dictated by health authorities such as. Temperature measurement, mandatory and permanent use of facemasks, use of gloves by staff, social distance signage, hand sanitizer dispensers, periodic sanitization, operation with open windows and doors, among others.

10. Stores and services in general, other than those above mentioned.

- COESPRISSON is responsible of security in coordination with local authorities.
- Will operate from 6:00 to 22:00 hours.
- Will operate at 75% of its maximum capacity.
- Pharmacies and medical services open without time limits.
- Compliance with current health safety protocols dictated by the health authorities, such as: temperature measurement, mandatory and permanent use of facemasks, use of gloves by staff, social distance signage, hand sanitizer dispensers, periodic sanitization, operation with open windows and doors, among others.

11. Churches and cult centers

- COESPRISSON is responsible of security in coordination with local authorities.
- Will operate from 6:00 to 22:00 hours.
- Will operate at 50% in closed spaces and 60% in open spaces.
- Compliance with current sanitary safety protocols issued by the health authorities, such as: temperature measurement, mandatory and permanent use of facemasks, use of gloves by staff, social distance signage, hand sanitizer dispensers, periodic sanitization, operation with open windows and doors, among others.

12. Applicable measures to the entire tourist destinations population

- Mandatory and permanent use of facemasks.



- Social distance of at least 5 feet.
- Frequent hand washing and use of hand sanitizer.
- Respect the maximum occupancy in passenger and transport vehicles.
- We encourage the Stay-at-Home strategy, as far as possible.

13. Vehicle Check Point at tourist destinations, beaches, spas, rivers, lagoons, dams, and traditional centers of coexistence accesses.

- Security must be coordinated by local authorities with the participation of security companies and competent government employees.

14. Anticipated mobile modules to contagions detection.

- Security must be coordinated by Public Health Secretariat.
- Rapid antigen and antibody tests will be carried out randomly.
- These mobile modules will travel to different points established by municipal authorities and the Public Health Secretariat.
